1) PLACE VALUE -

The digits of a number express the values of their own when the number is given in expanded form and read in words. The value of a digit when expressed in expanded form of the number is called its place value in the number.

Example 1-

Find the place value of the underlined digit in the number 645.

Solution –

H	T	O	
6	4	5	The place value of 4 = (4 × 10) = 40

ANS - Place value of 4 in 645 is 40 or forty.

Example 2-

Find the place value of the underlined digit in the number 708.

Solution –

H	T	O	
7	0	8	The place value of 7 = (7 × 100) = 700

ANS- Place value of 7 in 708 is 700 or seven hundred.

2) FACE VALUE -

Face value of a digit in a number is the digit itself.

Example 1-

Find the face value of the underlined digit in the number 567.

Solution –

H T O

5 6 7 ANS – The face value of 5 is 5 .

Example 2-

Find the face value of the underlined digit in the number 658.

Solution –

H T O

6 5 8

ANS- The face value of 8 in 658 is 8.

Chapter - 3

Changes in transport system

Transport :- Taking or carrying people or goods from one place to another by the help of a vehicle, is called transport. Eg - Ship, train, aircraft etc.

Different types of transport :-

There are three types of transport.

- i) Land transport.
- ii) Water transport.
- iii) Air transport.

Land Transport :-

Land transport is a means of transport that carries human or goods from one place to another place on land. Eg - Train, bus, car, bicycle etc.

Water transport :-

Water transport carries good or people in the water. Eg - Ship, boat , canoe etc.

Air transport :-

Air transport travels on the air. This is the the fastest mode of transport. Eg - Aeroplane, helicopter etc.

Children you all know that there are 26 letters in the English alphabet. The letter **a , e , i , o , u** are called **Vowels** and the remaining 21 letters are called **Consonants**.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

- The word 'A' 'An' 'The' are called **Articles**.
- There are two kinds of Articles
 - i) **Indefinite articles** i.e 'a' & 'an'. They are indefinite articles as they do not refer to any particular person, place, animal or thing.
Example: a) This is **a** pen.
b) John took **an** umbrella.
 - ii) **Definite article** i.e. 'the'. It is a definite article as it points out a particular person , place, animal or thing.
Example: a) **The** sun rise in **the** east.
b) **The** Bible is a holy book of **the** Christian.
- 'A' is used before a word begins with a consonant sound. example- a boy, a woman, a house, etc
- 'An' is used before a word begins with a vowel sound. example-an enemy, an orange, an umbrella, etc
- Similarly **example-a one-rupee note, a one-eyed man**. We use 'a' before the word starts with '**one**' because it begins with a consonant sound '**w**'.
- Again words like **university, union**, etc begin with a consonant sound '**yu**' we use 'a' before it.
- **An** is used before a word starts with a vowel sound. example- an honest, an historic, etc
