

c) **Rinse mouth well after eating.**






DIGESTIVE SYSTEM OF HUMAN

Solution- Cost of television set = Rs. 4832

Cost of refrigerator set= + Rs. 2796

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CHAPTER- 1 [NOUNS]

A **noun** is a naming word. It can be the name of a thing, person, place, animal or feeling. Mainly noun is divided into four types: *Proper Noun*, *Common Noun*, *Abstract Noun*, and *Collective Noun*.

Examples of Noun:

Naming People: It could be a name of any person, for example- John, Fatima, Singh, Michael, Tom and so on.

Naming Place: It could be a name of any place, for example- America, China, Church, Taj Mahal, Paris and so on.

Naming Things: Naming things are like Car, Hat, Bottle, Table, Chair, Ball and so on.

Naming Animals: It could be a name of any animal, for example- Tiger, Lion, Rabbit, Chicken, Horse and so on.

Naming Feeling/ Qualities/ Ideas: Joy, Fear, Beauty, Strength, Anger



CALENDARS AND TIMELINES (SET II)



Timeline:-

A timeline is a chart or table of historical events in a chronological order.

Features of Timeline:-

- (i) It shows us the events along with its time of happening.
- (ii) It shows the events in chronological order.

“AD” or “CE”:-

“AD” is the short form of “Anno Domini”. It also known as “CE” or “Common Era” which refers to the time since after the birth of Lord Jesus.

“BC” or “BCE”:-

“BC” stands for the term “Before Christ” that refers to the time period before the birth of Lord Jesus. It is also known as “BCE” or “Before Common Era”.
