- One dimensional motion-It is the motion of any object in a straight line.
 - Distance > Displacement, Distance \neq 0, Displacement=0
 - Speed=distance/time
 - Velocity=displacement/time
 - Speed= +ve always, velocity= +ve as well as -ve, average speed \neq 0, average velocity=0
 - Acceleration= change of velocity/time
 - Retardation= -ve acceleration.

Composition is the collection of written language into a text that has meaning. It is usually a long piece of writing.

In the examination you will be asked to write a composition of 300-350 words, the purpose is to test your ability to present your ideas in a logical, coherent manner and in grammatically correct English.

Students, you do not have to be a good writer to write well. Writing is a process. Learning to treat writing as a series of small steps will make writing a composition much easier.

HOW TO WRITE A GOOD COMPOSITION:

1. Choose a topic that you are interested in and can write about.
2. Choose a topic that will give you a lot of freedom to express your views.
3. Get a clear understanding of the topics given.
4. Try to make the correct choice and then stick to the same topic when writing an essay.
[Sometimes it happens that a student makes a wrong choice and begins writing. Half way he gets stuck and struggles for ideas to continue. When he cannot, he scratches out the entire composition and starts writing again on a new topic. This leads to wastage of time and energy and as a result he gets nervous. So it is very important to make the correct choice while writing out a composition.]
5. Prepare an outline.
