1. What is an alphabet? What are the two types of alphabet?

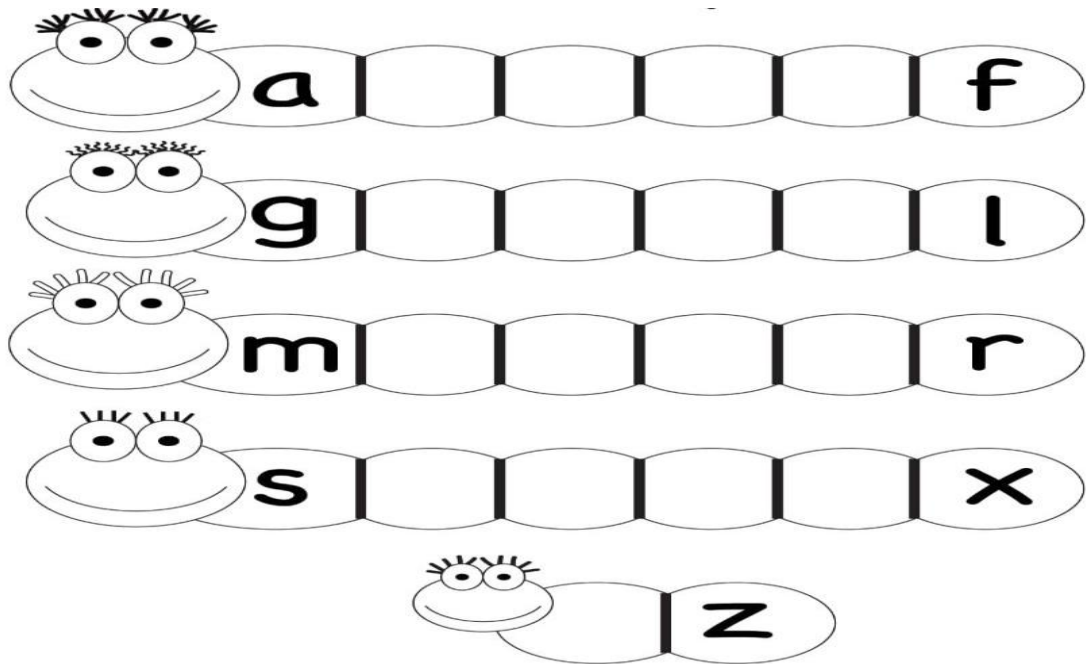
